Visual Coordinations (VC) is a step by step decorating technique in which the architectural features of a room are the foundation on which to build. VC looks at the architectural features of a home like the room shape, windows, and focal points to determine where to place the furniture and accessories. As a result, the furnishings are in harmony with the architecture resulting in a room that is welcoming and feels right.

- First, the room is broken down and emptied as much as possible. This first step is critical in order to read the architecture of the room and start the process with a blank slate.
- Second, the furniture is positioned with respect to the architecture starting with the largest piece of seating furniture and working down to the smaller items.
- Third, the artwork is hung with respect to the wall shapes and connected to the furniture.
- Last the lamps and accessories are layered to enhance the style and personality of the space.

Some of the most common decorating dilemmas can be solved with VC

- Make a space that feels small and cramped feel open and less crowded.
- Do not having money for a remodel but want a new look.
- Want to buy new furniture but are overwhelmed and afraid of making a mistake.
